Antonin Dvorak(1841-1904) was a Czech composer of the Romantic period in classical music. On a visit to the United States in 1893, he was so moved by the Native American's and African-American's style of music that he wrote his best known work - "The New World Symphony". "Largo", meaning slowly, is the second movement from that symphony.

John Newton wrote the words to Amazing Grace between 1760 and 1770. The words were based on an experience he had at sea in 1748. That day he was caught in a bad storm and thought his ship was going to sink. John said it was the day of his conversion, when he subjected his will to a higher power and felt that God had addressed him through the storm and grace began to work.
